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# JRA2 revised Goals

- Interim requirements doc ready for finalisation
- Consensus on how to continue next year
- detail working plan for tools deployment/refinement
  
- A step forward in answering those open points:
  - WI2: missing functionality in “The Toolset” identified
  - WI3: missing functionality in the co-ordination infrastructure identified



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# JRA2 WI3 original Goals

- agree on a common set of severity classification of incidents;
- agree on response actions and response time for incidents;
- Exchange electronic credentials;
- agree on a minimal format for incident information exchange;
- establish a common trouble ticket systems;
- deploy and pilot in test-operational environment the set of tools developed by WI2;
- agree/disagree on how to handle IPR related incidents.



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# JRA2 WI3 revised Goals

- we conclude the report on the existing coordination infrastructure and document the Common Practices
- we start working on the definition of use cases for advanced CERT interaction
- create a Best Common Practice document for new teams which are starting up and wish to join the club
- we continue to be the testbed for policy (WI1) and tools (WI2)



# JRA2 WI3 revised Activities

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- Formally close the trust loop with a PGP Key signing party at next meeting
- Start using PGP signed messages ONLY among teams for multiple CERT/CSIRT related incidents
- Start using the JRA2 IODEF profile for incident information exchange (on-the-road adjustment still possible)
- Use of available tools (WI2 and others) to integrate information and perform actions with early warning, or better post-mortem incident analysis.
- Bring as many new teams as possible at cruise speed
